Key Instant Recall Facts

YEAR 4 KIRF CARD - TERM 2

This half term your children are working towards achieving their individual KIRF targets, indicated below. The ultimate aim is for your child to be able to recall these facts instantly!

To know the multiplication and division facts from the 6 x table.

By the end of this half term, children should be able to recall all the facts for the 6 times table. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

SIX Times Table

$0 \times 6 = 0$	$0 \div 6 = 0$
$1 \times 6 = 6$	6 ÷ 6 = 1
$2 \times 6 = 12$	$12 \div 6 = 2$
$3 \times 6 = 18$	$18 \div 6 = 3$
$4 \times 6 = 24$	$24 \div 6 = 4$
$5 \times 6 = 30$	$30 \div 6 = 5$
$6 \times 6 = 36$	$36 \div 6 = 6$
$7 \times 6 = 42$	$42 \div 6 = 7$
$8 \times 6 = 48$	$48 \div 6 = 8$
$9 \times 6 = 54$	$54 \div 6 = 9$
$10 \times 6 = 60$	60 ÷ 6 = 10
$11 \times 6 = 66$	66 ÷ 6 = 11
$12 \times 6 = 72$	72 ÷ 6 = 12

Play number ping pong!

Start of saying 'ping', child replies with 'pong'. Repeat and then convert to tables facts i.e. say 6 and they 36 or 10 and they say 60.

You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day. Building confidence in mathematics is crucial so be pleased with their efforts and always encourage with praise.
