Jewellery Children may wear a single pair of plain studs. Children must be able to remove earrings for PE by themselves. *See additional notes overleaf A watch may be worn. No rings, necklaces or bracelets.

Additional notes regarding piercings in PE

Piercings must be removed/removable for PE.

- Where piercings cannot be removed, (newly pierced ears only) they must be adequately taped up prior to the lesson by the parent/family at home.
- An acknowledgement must be signed and agreed that this is against our advice during this interim period. (Acknowledgement attached).
- Parents should arrange for piercings at the beginning of the school holidays where possible.
